Good work team!

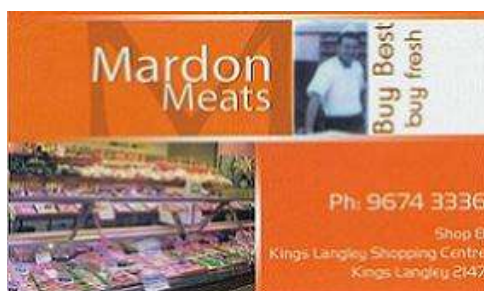
