Will applied himself to this task by playing with a straight bat, defending stoutly when necessary and running hard in his innings of 44 (3 fours). Nick Chymiak also played an important innings of 26 (2 fours) with sound defence and good attacking strokes after he had established himself at the crease.

Unfortunately we were not able to push on from 4 -124 off 48 over's due to 3 run outs and being one player absent without leave.

Our final score of 136 off 53 over's was probably more than it looked given the conditions and gave us a few over's to bowl before stumps. These four over's produced 2 key wickets by Daniel Beattie and Liam Gillies. Liam knocked the stumps down to claim a "Rep" off the last ball of the day to have everyone in high spirits.

Our pressure game early on the second week produced results with Daniel B and Liam both claiming another scalp each. Daniel's C&B in his first over was sharp. Soon they were 6-17 off 16 over's with Nick C chiming in for 2 -7 having rearranged the stumps twice in quick succession.

A fight back by Wenty was extinguished by Will with a devastating spell of bowling producing 3 for 8. His final diving catch off Daniel Pesavento allowed us to enforce the follow on. We found the Wenty batsmen defending their wicket with determination in the second innings as we pushed hard for an outright. Daniel B and Liam bowled well with the second new ball but were unable to get the breakthrough. Liam bowled four consecutive maidens.

Wenty finished 2 for 44 with our intensity dropping. Our 25 wides and no balls in 29 over's a bit of a worry.

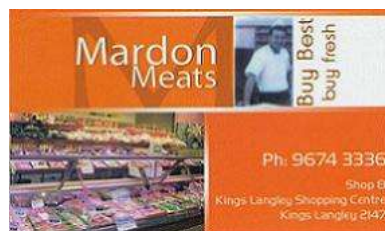
