It was pleasing to see our top order run well between the wickets with a number of short singles being taken particularly in the first 10 overs.

The Barbar's opener shouldered arms and was astonished to see his off stump uprooted. Liam very quickly cleaned up three and went close to a hatrick with his clever and deadly accurate swingers. Very soon the Barbars were 7 for 6 but had rotated the batting order so the job was not yet done with a couple of their best bats down the order. A rearguard effort saw their smallest player put in a gutsy batting effort before Will knocked him over. The final two batsmen were still dangerous so everyone was pleased with Daniel B's rocket throw to run out the last player with the total 29 and a huge come from behind win to the Kings Langley boys.

Fantastic swing bowling from Liam 4 for 2, Daniel B 2 for 2, Will 2 for 5 and Joshua 1 for 6. Liam's spell was sensational – good pace, movement in the air and stumps being knocked out of the ground. A great sight to see.

The bowlers were on top the whole game with 10 ducks being made by the batsmen in the two sides. 6 of these were ours so a bit of regrouping is required. Most importantly, this win takes us to Christmas in good spirits having won 5 out of 8 games. Plenty of things to work on but it has been a successful half of the season to date with the boys improving immensely from last year.

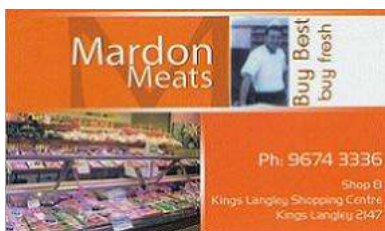
