Match Report

Losing the toss, we were put in the field in a must win game against bottom of the table Wenty Leagues. A big thankyou to Andrew Houseman for filling in once again this game and welcome back Tets from injury. With our bowling at full strength this game we were hoping to pick up regular wickets, however once again our fielding let us down. Rocket and Gareth opened the bowling and it was Gareth who picked up the 1st wicket with the score on 19 in the 6th over. However a big 2nd wicket partnership saw Wenty Leagues up to 94 before the next wicket fell in the 20th over thanks to Finchie. Another couple of wickets thanks to great bowling by Finchie saw Wenty at 4/122. Finchie the pick of the bowlers finishing with 3/18 off 8 overs. However with wickets in hand Wenty looked to pile on the runs. Owen and Tetley creating some opportunities, however our fielding once again let us down. Rocket and Gareth chipped in at the end to pick up wickets in the last few overs, with Wenty losing 4/12. Gareth finishing with 3/24 and Rocket 3/33. However the damage was done and Wenty had amassed 9/196 off 40 overs.

Needing to score at 5 and over from the word go, we were off to a disastrous start, losing Dave and Finchie both to run-outs, KL 2/14. Brent joined Paul and steadied the ship taking the score to 57 before Paul was out for a well played 28. With the score 3/70 at the halfway mark we knew the run-rate was going to have to lift. Houseman and Brent set about doing this, scoring 20 runs off the 1st two overs after drinks. The pair putting on 59 for the 4th wicket before Brent was out for 46 with the score on 116. Requiring another 81 runs in 13 overs we had to continue to score freely, however a collapse saw us staring down the barrel of defeat slumping to 6/119 (Houseman out for a quick 25). Terence tried to lift the run-rate before he was out for 15 and losing Jason to we were in big trouble at 8/136. Requiring 61 runs off 7 overs, Tetley and Rocket strolled to the crease. From the word go Tetley took to the bowling including taking 18 off one over.
