Match Report

After drinks the boys continued to bat well and got us to 76 before Terence was out for 34, well batted! Paul came to the crease and tried to up the tempo, hitting 7 before being trapped in front. Finchie joined Freney and began to lift the run rate before Freney was out for a solid 42. A progression of wickets saw Brent, and Matt go, before Finchie also fell for an exciting 31 runs including 1 four and 1 six, well batted. After such a good start we had slumped to 6/127, Dowie and Rocket set about restoring order and took the score to 146 before Rocket was out for 10. Tetley joined Dowie and took the score to 162 before Dowie fell for 18. When Sean smoked a ball and was caught on the boundary we were 9/169. Owen joined Tets and with instructions to bat out the overs, the pair saw us through to the 70 overs, with some aggressive hitting by Tets seeing the pair put on an unbeaten 33 runs in the last 5 overs. Owen joined Freney in the attack and continued to tie the batsmen down, picking up regular wickets along the way, never really giving Baulko a chance, Baulko all out for 121 in 56 overs. "Big O" the pick of the bowlers, cleaning up the tail to finish with 4/35 off 16 overs, and Dave Finishing with a very tidy 2/12 off 15.

Match Report

A mention must go to Daniel who really kept it tight with 0/16 off 10 overs.

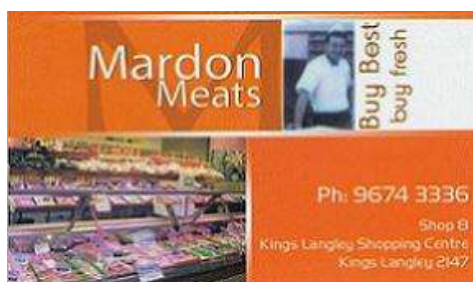
